

Carson City Photo Club Constitution

Adopted September 24, 2019

Article I—Name

This organization shall be known as the “Carson City Photo Club.”

Article II – Mission

The mission of the Carson City Photo Club (herein referred to as the “Club”) shall be to promote the enjoyment, mastery and furtherance of photography through cooperation, individual effort, and good fellowship.

Article III – Meetings

Regular meetings of the Club shall have place, date, and time suggested by the Executive Board with approval of a majority of the membership in attendance.

Article IV - Membership

Any person over 16 interested in photography may apply for membership by completing an application and paying the annual fee to the treasurer. Membership shall be from January to December, with annual dues pro-rated for individuals who join after January.

Article V - Officers

The following officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the membership in attendance: (1) President; (2) Secretary; (3) Treasurer.

Article VI – Committees

The activities of Club committees shall be determined by the Executive Board. Chairs of committees shall be appointed by the President, subject to approval by the Executive Board.

Article VII – Executive Board

The management of the Club shall be directed by the Executive Board consisting of the elected officers (Article V). The Executive Board shall meet in person or electronically as requested by the President to transact business of the Club. Two members of the board will constitute a quorum.

Article VIII – Amendments

Amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws may be proposed by any member to the Executive Board, and, if approved by a majority of members in attendance, will be incorporated into this Constitution and By-Laws.
